DISCIPLINE PIANO SOLO:

Competitors in the PIANO SOLO and PIANO DUO disciplines perform a free-choice program that must contain at least two compositions with duration as follows:

1. BABY CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2013 and younger – 3 min.

2. JUNIOR CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2011 and younger – 4 min.

3. FIRST CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2010 – 5 min.

4. SECOND CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2009 – 6 min.

5. THIRD CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2008 – 7 min.

6. FOURTH CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2007 – 8 min.

7. FIFTH CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2006 – 10 min.

8. SIXTH CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2004 and younger – 12 min.

9. SEVENTH CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2002 and younger – 15 min.

DISCIPLINE PIANO DUO (FOUR HANDS AND TWO PIANOS):

1. PRE-CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2012 and younger – 3 min.

2. FIRST CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2010 and younger – 5 min.

3. SECOND CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2008 and younger – 7 min.

4. THIRD CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2006 and younger – 9 min.

5. FOURTH CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2004 and younger- 11 min

6. FIFTH CATEGORY

Competitors born in 2002 and younger- 13 min

Competition rules

Article 1.

Elementary musical school „Vladimir Đorđević“ in Aleksinac, organizes first piano competition titled **Memorial „Sanja Pavlović“ from 23-30. December 2020**. This year the competition will be **ONLINE**.

Article 2.

The application deadline is **20. December 2020**, and the final results of the competition will be announced till **30. December 2020**.

Article 3.

The competition is structured in two disciplines **PIANO SOLO** and **PIANO DUO (FOUR HANDS AND TWO PIANOS)**.

Article 4.

The right to participate in the competition have all regular and part-time pupils from musical schools of Serbia and abroad.

Article 5.

Competitors will be judged by the jury of outstanding pianists and professors from Serbia and abroad.

Article 6.

The decision of the jury is final and irrevocable.

Article 7.

The number of obtained prizes for participants is unlimited.

Article 8.

In case of more than one competitor in the same category has received equal number of points, the prize will be awarded to the youngest participant.

Article 9.

Applicants are required to indicate in the application the name of the member of the jury who will be exempted from the judging if he is the professor of the candidate or is related to him.

Article 10.

The jury shall rank the competitors as follows:

I PRIZE from 90 to 100 points

II PRIZE from 80 to 89,99 points

III PRIZE from 70 to 79,99 points

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT from 60 to 69,99 points

- Awarded participant will get a diplomas, the winner of each category will be awarded with diploma and medal, while the winner of the each category (primary and high school) will receive a **LAUREATE** award (piano chair, diploma and the cup).

Article 11.

Candidates in discipline PIANO SOLO have to perform the programme from memory, while in discipline PIANO DUO candidates may use sheet music during the performance.

Article 12.

Candidates play a freely selected repertoire which must include at least two compositions up to a certain duration.

Article 13.

1. In PIANO DUO discipline, category is ranking according to year of birth of older candidate.

Article 14.

2. The application for the competition must be submitted no later than **December 20, 2020** and it could be send in two ways:

With the application, all candidates are required to submit a **copy of birth certificate** and **proof of payment the registration fee** in the following amount:

-for PIANO SOLO **1000 din**

-for PIANO DUO **1500 din**

For participants from abroad, registration fee is:

-for PIANO SOLO **10 eur**

- for PIANO DUO **15 eur**

The competitors should upload video with programme (it is allowed to upload programme in separated videos) on a **You Tube channel** with **name of the competitor and programme**. The videos should be **Public, with disabled comments**, with good quality and with ability to see a competitors face and instrument.
